The total number of candidates who can be registered for the Ph.D. programme, both full-time and part-time under a Supervisor, at any point of time shall not exceed **Four** for Assistant Professor, **Six** for Associate Professor and **Eight** for Professor (including Re-registered candidates) for a Supervisor working in the University Departments, Affiliated Colleges.
2. Research supervisors are permitted one additional candidate above the maximum limit, in order to admit candidates working in their research project funded by the State / Central Government or International Funding Agencies. This is against any future vacancy which may arise when any candidate submits the thesis.
3. A Research Supervisor shall not be permitted to get eligibility for research supervision from other University with the exception of centrally funded research institutions like CLRI, CECRI, NITTR, CSIR, CIPET, etc. However, the research supervisors shall indicate the list of students working in other Universities under their guidance. In any case, the maximum students shall not exceed the UGC norms.
4. A Supervisor / Co-Supervisor shall not supervise his/her immediate or close relative and to this effect he/she shall furnish a declaration in the column provided in the application form for admission.
5. Supervisors offer to be a co-supervisor for an inter-disciplinary study that will not be counted as Ph.D. guidance. However, the number of candidates under co-guidance be restricted to three.
6. The Supervisors shall not be permitted to register candidates for Ph.D. in the last two years of his/her service.
7. Whenever the Supervisors are transferred from their present place of employment to another place, the same should be intimated to the University, through proper channel, for approval of continuance of Supervisorship of candidates registered under them.
8. The Supervisors who wish to avail leave/lien/deputation beyond a period of **SIX MONTHS** shall nominate co-guides in the concerned subject for the candidates registered with them and the fact intimated to the University well in advance.
9. The Supervisors are permitted to guide M.Phil dissertation also if the said Department is recognized for conducting research leading to M.Phil [Full-Time] Degree and he/she may be permitted to register candidates as per the University norms.
